The ILA-ACRL representatives will be appointed by the Membership Committee and IASL representatives will be appointed by the IASL Board. Participation by community college librarians will also be encouraged.~~

~~iii. Support K-12 library programs, ensure collaboration to provide strong K-16 information literacy efforts throughout the state, and conduct assessment and advocacy.~~
